The Summit Center, Inc. Refinancing Transaction Summary

The Summit Center, Inc's application to the Town of Amherst Development Corporation for refinancing of certain outstanding obligations incurred by the Company with respect to the construction and equipping of various facilities providing educational services for developmentally disabled children and adults, located at 150 Stahl Road, 165 Creekside Drive, 25 Woodridge Drive, and 55-75 Pineview Drive in the Town of Amherst, Erie County, New York.

The Summit Center Inc., is financing all or a portion of the costs by the issuance of taxexempt/taxable revenue bonds in an aggregate principal amount sufficient to pay the cost of undertaking the Project, estimated to be approximately \$7,200,000 and not to exceed \$8,200,000. The Project will receive a mortgage recording tax exemption as a result of the participation of the Town of Amherst Development Corporation.

The applicant will receive up to \$82,000 in mortgage recording tax exemption.
